

ORDINANCE #2009 - 11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-22 WHICH ENACTED A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE, PROCESSING, REVIEW AND/OR REJECTION OF APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS TO ERECT SIGNS WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY; EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM FOR AN ADDITIONAL SIX (6) MONTH PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Doral Land Development Code regulates the permitting and construction of signs within the City of Doral; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-15 of the Doral Land Development Code prohibits all off-site signs such as billboards; and

WHEREAS, in October, 2008, the City Council adopted a moratorium on the acceptance, processing, review, and/or rejecting of applications for permits to erect signs to provide the City time to review and determine if Section 10 of the Doral Land Development Code to meet the requirements of the Florida and United States Constitutions; and

WHEREAS, the City needs additional time to consider amendments to Section 10 of the Land Development Code to further determine whether an amendment is needed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Doral to extend the moratorium on the acceptance, processing, review, and/or rejection of applications for sign permits, to provide time for the

City to review and determine if Section 10 of the Doral Land Development Code requires amendment to meet the requirements of the Florida and United States Constitutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. Moratorium Extended. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby extends the moratorium for an additional one hundred eighty (180) days from the effective date of this Ordinance on the acceptance, processing, review, and/or rejection of applications for permits to erect signs within the City.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby determines that all applications for sign permits which were received prior to the public notice of the adoption of this ordinance are exempt from this moratorium.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If any Section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

PASSED AND ADOPTED upon first reading and public hearing this 11th day of March, 2009.
