

RESOLUTION No. 22-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT WITH ENVIROWASTE SERVICES INC. FOR ITB #2013-32 CATCH BASIN MAINTENANCE PROGRAM UNDER THE SAME TERMS, COST, AND CONDITIONS, UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT EXTENSION AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2013, RFP #2013-32 “Catch Basin Maintenance Program” was issued for the purpose of providing catch basin maintenance services to the City’s stormwater drainage infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, a two-year contract with an option to renew for an additional two one-year periods was awarded to EnviroWaste Services Inc. via Resolution No. 14-36 (approved 5-0); and

WHEREAS, the initial two (2) year period of the contract expired on March 24, 2016, the first one-year extension expired on March 24, 2017, and the second and final one-year extension expired on March 24, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2018, Resolution No. 18-30 (approved 5-0) was adopted to extend the existing contract by 6-Months to allow the Public Works Department (PWD) to perform a market analysis due to the existing contracts competitive prices and the contract was extended until September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, On September 12, 2018, Resolution No. 18-156 (approved 4-0, 1 Absent/Excused) was adopted extending RFP #2013-32 for a contract period of two (2) years with the option to renew for an additional two one-year terms under the same terms, costs, and conditions. The final extension period approved per Resolution No.

18-156 is set to expire on September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City's current contract with EnviroWaste Services Inc. provides the City with competitive prices as evidenced by the number of municipalities and Doral communities that have adopted the City's contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Councilmembers extends ITB #2013-32, under the same terms, costs and conditions, until September 30, 2023 to determine the best course of action for the City of Doral starting in Fiscal Year 2023-24, either to proceed with the maintenance program via in-house services or advertise a new solicitation to allow competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available in the current Fiscal Year and will be budget in subsequent Fiscal Years in the Public Works Stormwater Fund – Other Current Charges Account, Account No. 401.80005.500340.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The extension of ITB #2013-32 until September 30, 2023 under the same terms, costs and conditions, in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract extension and expend budgeted funds on the behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby

authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Mariaca who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cabrera and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
