RESOLUTION #2007 – 22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA EXPRESSING ITS DESIRE TO LEASE OR PURCHASE 6.45 ACRES OR MORE, IF AVAILABLE AND CONTIGUOUS, OF PROPERTY FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO USE FOR A PARK OR RECREATIONAL PURPOSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral have been informed of an opportunity to lease / purchase 6.45 acres of property which lies south of the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department to use for a park or recreational purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has been informed by Miami-Dade County that they are not interested in leasing/purchasing that acreage; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the City to lease / purchase 6.45 acres or more, if available and contiguous, from the State of Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing "WHEREAS' clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorize the City Manager or his designee to negotiate with the State of Florida for the lease / purchase of the 6.45 acres or more, if available and contiguous, to be used for a park or recreational purpose.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council.
