ORDINANCE NO. 2004-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-13 WHICH PROVIDED FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY CHARTER BY AMENDING, AMONG OTHER THINGS, SECTION 9.6 "REGULATORY CONTROL" AND SECTION 9.10 "MODIFICATIONS"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sections 6.01 of the Charter of the City of Doral provides that the Council may, by ordinance, propose amendments to the Charter subject to approval by the electorate at the next general election or at a special election called for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Council determined to submit certain proposed Charter amendments for approval or disapproval by the electors and adopted Ordinance 2004-13 to further that end; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has now decided to repeal that Ordinance and adopt a new Ordinance that will be supported by Miami-Dade County;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Repeal.</u> Ordinance No. 2004-13 adopted by the City Council on July 14, 2004 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption on ten days after second reading.
