A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADOPT THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES (DMS) CONTRACT No.: DMS-19/20-006A FOR ATT FIRSTNET SOLUTIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE ANNUAL BUDGETED FUNDS, FOR THE PERIOD SET FORTH AND ANY APPROVED ADDITIONAL SUBSEQUENT EXTENSIONS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, State of Florida, Department of Management Services (DMS) Contract No.: DMS-19/20-006A ATT Mobile Communication Services for ATT's FirstNet Solution portfolio and functionalities developed by ATT under authority granted to it by the First Responder Network; and

WHEREAS, On February 12, 2020, Mayor and Council approved Resolution No 20-169, ATT State of Florida Licensing SUNCOM Contract No.: DMS-10/11-008A for services which on the FirstNet network which provides the country's first nationwide public safety communications platform dedicated to first responders and government. Being built with AT&T, in public-private partnership with the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority), FirstNet is bringing public safety a much-needed technology upgrade to help them connect to the critical information they need for daily operations and emergencies. The DMS-10/11-008A State of Florida contract is expired, ATT has signed a new State of Florida, DMS-19/20-006A agreement and has moved all existing FirstNet customers to the new; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Council approve the use contracts competitively entered into by other governmental entities in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V,

of the City Code, and vendors participating in State of Florida, Department of Management Services Contract No., DMS-19/20-006A ATT Mobile Communication Services for ATT's FirstNet Solution consists of a portfolio of wireless voice, vehicle tracking devices and services, pots line, IP Flex/VOIP, texting and data service plans, along with ancillary equipment, services, features and functionalities developed by AT&T under authority granted to it by the First Responder Network.; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager's Office respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Councilmembers adopt the State of Florida Department of Management Services Contract No.: DMS-19/20-006A ATT Mobile Communication Services for ATT's FirstNet Solution in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds, for the period set forth and any approved additional subsequent extensions. Funds are allocated yearly in the IT Communications & Freight Account# 001.22005.500410; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Council approve the use contracts competitively entered into by other governmental entities in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code, and vendors participating in State of Florida, Department of Management Services Contract No., DMS-19/20-006A ATT Mobile Communication Services for ATT's FirstNet Solution consists of a portfolio of wireless voice, vehicle tracking devices and services, pots line, IP Flex/VOIP, texting and

data service plans, along with ancillary equipment, services, features and functionalities developed by AT&T under authority granted to it by the First Responder Network.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and other contractual documents, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
