

RESOLUTION NO. 10- 160

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, FORMALLY INITIATING THE PROCEDURE OUTLINED IN CHAPTER 164.1052, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO COMMENCE THE "CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCEDURE" OUTLINED IN THE STATUTE PRIOR TO INITIATING LITIGATION AGAINST MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IN REFERENCE TO THE TRANSIT SYSTEM SURTAX; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral (the "City") has previously expressed its desire to obtain from Miami-Dade County its fair share of the Miami-Dade County Transit System Surtax, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously directed the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate with the County in order to obtain such funds, and

WHEREAS, to date, the County has not agreed to provide to the City its fair share of the Miami-Dade County Transit System Surtax; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 164.1052, it is necessary for the City Council to adopt a resolution stating its intention to initiate a "Conflict Resolution Procedure" against the County, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 164.1052 provides for certain notice provisions to the County, in order to give the County the opportunity to attempt to resolve the matter with the City prior to initiating litigation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing recital paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Doral hereby approves a resolution stating its intention to initiate the "Conflict Resolution Procedure" as outlined in Section 164.1052, Florida Statutes, with respect to the Transit System Surtax.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.


