## **RESOLUTION No. 06 - 79**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS AND TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TEW CARDENAS, LLP FOR THE PROVISION OF FEDERAL LOBBYING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF DORAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to protect and represent its municipal interests with the United States Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the 1<sup>st</sup> session of the 110<sup>th</sup> Congress will convene in January 2007 and, due to the subsequent limited amount of time, Staff respectfully recommends that the City Council of the City of Doral waive the RFP process consistent with Section 12.9 of the City's Purchasing and Procurement Ordinance so as to procure federal lobbying services; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully recommends that the City Council of the City of Doral authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Tew Cardenas, LLP for the provision of federal lobbying services for the City of Doral.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby waives the RFP process in the procurement of federal lobbying services and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Tew Cardenas, LLP for the provision of federal lobbying services for the City of Doral.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
