The City of Doral authorizes the firm of H & J Asphalt, Inc. to proceed with the provision of Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping within Vanderbilt Neighborhood Phase IV – Final Phase (Roadway Section #s 23051, 25702, 28073, 28074, 28075, 25686). Where H & J Asphalt, Inc. is a pre-qualified provider of Construction Services selected in accordance with RFQ 2022-13 requirements and approved by the City Council on August 9, 2022, through Resolution 22-145. The work shall be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Construction Services Agreement between H & J Asphalt, Inc. and the City of Doral dated August 9, 2022, and the attached Proposal submitted on October 31, 2023, submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from H & J Asphalt, Inc. submitted on October 31, 2023. The schedule requires the work to be performed within 30 calendar days from NTP. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed based on the schedule of values submitted by H & J Asphalt, Inc. with a not to exceed amount of \$110,886.60, which includes a 10% contingency amount for any unforeseen conditions.

You are required by the Continuing Construction Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award. Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Construction Agreement dated August 9, 2022, between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Construction Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

This Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in two (2) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.

RESOLUTION No. 23-220

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH H & J ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF MILLING, RESURFACING, AND STRIPING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES WITHIN THE VANDERBILT NEIGHBORHOOD PHASE IV (FINAL PHASE) (ROAD SECTIONS 23051, 25702, 28073, 28074, 28075, AND 25686 AS IDENTIFIED IN THE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PLAN) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,886.60 WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORSEEN CONDITIONS; RECOGNIZING THAT H & J ASPHALT, INC., IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2022, the City of Doral (“City”) issued and advertised Request for Qualification No. 2022-13 “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” (the “RFQ”); and

WHEREAS, the evaluation committee recommended that the City Council award the RFQ to the top four (4) ranked firms, H&J Asphalt, Inc., H&R Paving, Inc., Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., and General Asphalt; and

WHEREAS, in August of 2022, pursuant to Resolution No. 22-144, the City Council accepted the recommendation of the evaluation committee and awarded the RFQ to aforementioned firms, thereby establishing a pool of construction firms for “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” (“Pre-qualified Pool of Firms”); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (“PWD”) is in need of a firm to provide Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping within the Vanderbilt Neighborhood Phase IV – Final Phase (Roadway Section #s 23051, 25702, 28073, 28074, 28075, 25686 as identified in the Pavement Rehabilitation Plan) (the “Work”); and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from the Pre-qualified Pool of Firms for the Work; and

WHEREAS, H&J Asphalt, Inc., provided the attached proposal and was deemed the lowest bid proposal with a not to exceed amount of \$110,886.60 which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager’s Office respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 11 for H&J Asphalt, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, for the provision of Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping within the Vanderbilt Neighborhood Phase IV – Final Phase (Roadway Section #s 23051, 25702, 28073, 28074, 28075, 25686 as identified in the Pavement Rehabilitation Plan) in an amount not to exceed \$110,886.60, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available in the Public Works Transportation Fund, Account Num. 101.80005.500633.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Council hereby approves Work Order No. 11 to H&J Asphalt, Inc., for Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping within the Vanderbilt Neighborhood Phase IV – Final Phase (Roadway Section #s 23051, 25702, 28073, 28074, 28075, 25686) in an amount not to exceed \$110,886.60, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City, in an amount not to exceed \$110,886.60.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
