RESOLUTION NO. 13-119

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE, ADOPTING THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN HUB CITY FORD AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT SERVICES, WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY CODE, FOR THE PROVISION OF FOUR (4) NEW POLICE SERVICE VEHICLES IN AN **AMOUNT EQUAL** TO \$74.380.00: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH RESPECT TO THE AGREEMENT APPROVED HEREIN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN **EFFECTIVE DATE (POLICE)**

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department seeks to purchase four (4) police service aide vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Hub City Ford has an existing state term contract (#071-000-13-1) for the purchase of new automobiles, passenger vans, cargo vans, sport utility vehicles, light pickup and chassis-cab trucks, and low speed vehicles with or without installed options including various truck bodies and accessories. The contract includes police/special service vehicles and motorcycles (marked and unmarked)" and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council adopt the existing agreement between Hub City Ford and the Florida Department of Management Services, which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code for the provision of four (4) new police service aide vehicles in an amount equal to \$74,380.00, and further requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City with respect to the agreement approved herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral Florida authorizes the adoption of the existing agreement between Hub City Ford and the Florida Department of Management Services, which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code, for the provision of four (4) new police service aide vehicles in an amount equal to \$74,380.00, and further authorizes the City Manager to expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City with respect to the agreement approved herein.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
