

RESOLUTION No. 16-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF 19 HARRIS SCAN PORTABLE POLICE RADIOS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$72,938.80 FROM MIAMI DADE COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI DADE COUNTY AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") seeks to purchase 19 Harris Scan Portable Radios, with accessories and programming ("Radios") for its Police Department; and

WHEREAS, section 2-322 of the City Code provides that the City is authorized to enter into bids or contracts entered into by other governmental authorities provided that the governmental authority has followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of the bid or contract in question which is substantially similar to the competitive bidding procedure outlined in the City Code; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, pursuant to City Council Resolution 15-77, the City purchased 10 Radios from Miami-Dade County, after it was determined that Miami-Dade pricing bested any prices obtained by the City in its own competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Staff, now, has recommended that the City Council approve the purchase of 19 Harris Scan Portable Radios, with accessories and programming, in an amount not to exceed \$72,938.80, from Miami Dade County (funded in account 001.60005.500640 Capital Outlay), and authorize the City Manager to enter into an Agreement in furtherance of same; and

WHEREAS, Staff further requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager and the City Attorney to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Miami-Dade County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to section 2-322 of the City Code of Ordinance, the purchase of 19 Harris Scan Portable Police Radios, with accessories and programming, in an amount not to exceed \$72,938.80 from Miami Dade County is hereby approved. This purchase is funded in account 001.60005.500640 Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Rodriguez and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
