

RESOLUTION NO. 06 - 17

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT ALL CURRENT PROPOSALS RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO THE 58TH STREET LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENT RFP AND RE-ISSUE ANOTHER REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PROVISION OF LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG N.W. 58TH STREET IN THE CITY OF DORAL WHICH SHALL INCLUDE THE MODIFICATIONS RECOMMENDED BY THE PROJECT DESIGNER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City wishes to beautify and improve the landscaping of the City for the benefit of its residential and commercial communities; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager's Office received five (5) responses to the Request for Proposals (RFP) issued for landscape improvements along N.W. 58th Street between N.W. 97th Avenue and N.W. 107th Avenue on February 21, 2006 prior to the 10:00 a.m. deadline; and

WHEREAS, upon the request of the City Council on March 8, 2006 to review the original cost estimate, Font Designs, Inc., the project Designer (Designer), was contacted and requested to provide comment on the significant price difference between its estimate and the bids received; and

WHEREAS, based upon the information provided by the Designer in the letter attached hereto as "Exhibit A." staff respectfully recommends the rejection of the current proposals so that the project can be advertised again with the modifications recommended by the Designer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to reject all current proposals received on the previously issued RFP on N.W. 58th Street landscaping improvements and reissue an RFP for landscaping improvements along the portion of N.W. 58th Street as stated above including the modifications specified by the Designer

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
