

RESOLUTION No. 11 – 51

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION CAMERAS FOR THE NEW POLICE DEPARTMENT BUILDING FROM AWARE DIGITAL, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$8,038.70; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department has relocated to the Richmond Building at 8420 N.W. 52 Street, Doral, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the new building requires the installation of closed circuit television (CCTV) cameras to monitor the parking areas, ingress and egress from the building; and

WHEREAS, Aware Digital, Inc., the original installer of this equipment and current vendor for the City of Doral on several projects, has submitted a proposal to provided the necessary CCTV coverage of the new building; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City manager to purchase CCTV cameras for the new Police Department Building from Aware Digital, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$8,038.70.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to purchase CCTV cameras for the new Police Department Building from Aware Digital, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$8,038.70.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


