

RESOLUTION NO. 07 - 101

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, OPPOSING THE PROPOSED PROVISION IN THE SCHOOL INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT THAT PROVIDES SINGLE-WIDE DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF DETERMINING CONCURRENCY; SUPPORTING THE USE OF CHARTER SCHOOLS AS A FORM OF CONCURRENCY MITIGATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT THIS RESOLUTION TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY MAYOR AND COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the proposed Interlocal Agreement, which is being drafted consistent with State concurrency law requirements, currently provides for a single-wide district to be used for the purposes of determining that concurrency standards have been met; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral opposes the use of a single-wide district for the purposes of determining concurrency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral supports that Charter schools be allowed to be used as a credit for mitigation purposes and such credit should be provided for in the proposed Interlocal Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Doral hereby opposes the use of single-wide districts for the purposes of determining concurrency.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Doral hereby supports Charter schools to be used as a form of mitigation and the use of Charter schools as a form of mitigation and such credit should be expressly provided for in the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to transmit a copy of this Resolution to each Miami-Dade County Commissioner and the Mayor of Miami-Dade County.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council and is binding on all successors and assigns.

WHEREAS, a motion to approve the Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Cabrera, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman Van-Name and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
