

RESOLUTION NO. 12 –55

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA RETROACTIVELY APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,364.00 BY THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE COUNTYWIDE PRISONER PROCESSING PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department has been allocated \$11,364.00 by Miami-Dade County towards the Association of Chiefs of Police (MDCACP) countywide Prisoner Processing Project; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the MDCACP Prisoner Processing Project is to expedite the booking process by having arrest information available at correction / detention facilities by the time the officer arrives with the arrestee; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council retroactively approve the application for funds in the amount of \$11,364.00 by the City of Doral Police Department from MDCACP countywide Prisoner Processing Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby retroactively approves the application for funds in the amount of \$11,364.00 by the City of Doral Police Department from MDCACP countywide Prisoner Processing Project.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
