## **RESOLUTION NO. 12-96**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE THREE (3) 2013 FORD FUSION HYBRID VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE PLANNING 7 ZONING AND BUILDING DEPARTMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00 PER VEHICLE AS IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY TO DO SO PURSUANT TO SEC. 2-321 OF THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Department; and the Building Departments of the City of Doral has budgeted for the purchase of three (3) new Ford Escape Hybrid vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles would be used to replace some of the oldest vehicles in the fleet, two (2) 2005 Chevy Cavaliers and two (2) Jeep Liberties; and

WHEREAS, both the Planning and Zoning Department and Building Department would like to be consistent with the City's efforts on green initiatives in purchasing vehicles that average at least 40 miles per gallon; and

WHEREAS, three quotes were received in which Don Reid Ford provided the lowest quote, and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the competitive procurement process and authorize the City Manager to purchase three (3) 2013 Ford Fusion Vehicles from Don Reid Ford for the use of the Planning and Zoning Department and the Building Department in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 per vehicle as it is in the best interest of the City to do so pursuant to Section 2-321 of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby waives the competitive procurement process and authorize the City Manager to purchase three (3) 2013 Ford Fusion Vehicles from Don Reid Ford for the use of the Planning and Zoning Department and the Building Department in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 per vehicle as it is in the best interest of the City to do so pursuant to Section 2-321 of the City Code.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
