

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2004-60 CALLING FOR THE CHARTER AMENDMENT RELATING TO SECTIONS 9.6 REGULATORY CONTROL AND 9.10 "MODIFICATIONS" TO BE PLACED ON THE NOVEMBER 2, 2004 BALLOT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Enabling Resolution 2004-60 submitting the proposed amendments to the electorate pursuant to Section 5.03 of the Dade County Charter is hereby rescinded and repealed such that amendments to the Charter contained therein shall not be placed on the ballot and it shall not be proposed for amendment.

Section 2. Copies of this resolution, Resolution 2004-60 and the full text of the City Charter amendment now proposed shall be removed from the office of the City Clerk located at 8300 NW 53rd Avenue, Suite #100, Doral, Florida and merely retained in the public records.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilwoman Ruiz, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman Van Name and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


