A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REQUEST LETTERS OF INTEREST FOR THE CITY OF DORAL PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT PROGRAMMING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to offer its residents varied and interesting programming at its different parks; and

WHEREAS, with the opening of Doral Park in early 2007, the Parks & Recreation Department will offer a variety of athletic, dance, fitness and cultural arts classes; and

WHEREAS, as a means of securing Instructors to conduct these classes on behalf of the Parks & Recreation Department, Staff respectfully requests that Council authorize the City Manager to request Letters of Interest (L.O.I.); and

WHEREAS, through the L.O.I. process the City would:

- Solicit and advertise the L.O.I. to identify potential Instructors or Service Providers;
- 2. Review and select qualified Instructors or Service Providers to enter into an agreement not to exceed one year;
- 3. Receive a percentage of the gross generated by the fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida authorizes the City Manager to request the L.O.I., following the process as stated in the above "whereas clause," for the provision of securing Instructors and Service Providers for Parks and Recreation Department programming.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
