VANDERBILT PARK TRAFFIC CALMING STUDY <u>ADDITIONAL WORK</u> SCOPE OF SERVICES / PLAN

It is understood that the purpose of this study was to assess the need for traffic calming for the Vanderbilt Park Area.



The Vanderbilt Park is bound by NW 25th Street to the South, NW 97th Ave to the East, NW 28th Terrace to the North and NW 102nd Ave to the West. As part of traffic calming study, recommendation of traffic calming devices were identified to solve cut through and speeding problems and meet the consensus of the neighborhood.

Some residents have complained about receiving cut through violation tickets since the installation of the following traffic calming device:

Right Turn Restriction Signs (4:00-7:00 PM) on NW 97th Avenue and NW 28th Terrace/NW 27th Terrace/ NW 27th Street - Based on the right turning volume from NW 97th Avenue, right turn restriction sign was only warranted for NW 28th Terrace. This right turning traffic when restricted is expected to shift

to the next two intersections on NW 27th Terrace & NW 27th Street, therefore it was recommended that right turn restriction signs (4:00-7:00 PM) be placed on NW 97th Avenue at NW 27th Terrace & NW 27th Street as well.

This issue was brought to the attention of the City Council and as a follow-up to Council's request the right turn restriction sign was agreed to be further researched. As part of this request and to propose a right turn restriction sign that better serves the residents, the following additional tasks are proposed:

- Task 1 Research any enforcement signage as per Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and check design and placement
- Task 2 Coordinate with Miami-Dade County Traffic Engineering Division to seek approval of the enforcement signage
- Task 3 Prepare material, sketches and presentation for Final Design Public Workshop
- Task 4 Administer Final Design Public Workshop to discuss cut through issues and implementation of the new sign
