A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL. FLORIDA. APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (MDCPWWMD) FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE VANDERBILT PARK TRAFFIC CONTROL AND CALMING AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT: PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") completed a Traffic Calming Study for the Vanderbilt Park Community and developed mitigation improvements that will be implemented in two Phases (Phase 1 and Phase 2); and

WHEREAS, the City mailed out ballots to all the Vanderbilt Park residents to vote on the recommended Phase 1 and Phase 2 traffic calming improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City received the necessary two-thirds (2/3) votes from the Vanderbilt Park residents in favor of having the City implement the recommended Phase 1 and Phase 2 improvements; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Public Works and Waste Management Department ("MDCPWWMD") has jurisdiction over traffic control devices within the City of Doral and provided the attached Intergovernmental Agreement that needs to be executed by the City prior to the installation of the traffic control and calming devices; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City wish to enter into an Intergovernmental agreement substantially in substantially the form of the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for the installation and maintenance of these traffic control and calming devices, and assuming liabilities associated with the installation of said devices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that entering into the Agreement is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Approval.</u> The Intergovernmental Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is approved. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation</u>. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

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Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Results

In December 2014 the City of Doral Public Works Department began the process of performing a Traffic Calming Study to evaluate and recommend improvements that will enhance the livability within the Vanderbilt Park community. The City solicited the residents' input every step of the way through two Public Workshops.

The Kick-off Public Workshop was held on Thursday, December 11, 2014 at the Doral Government Center. This Workshop offered residents the opportunity to voice their concerns on traffic related issues in the neighborhood and ensured staff was conducting the necessary traffic data collection to address the residents' needs.

Once the data was collected, analyzed and recommended improvements were developed, Doral Public Works Department coordinated with Miami-Dade County to have the study's findings and recommendations approved. On Thursday, April 9, 2015, the Final Public Workshop was held at the Doral Government to present the study findings and the Miami-Dade County approved improvements. The recommendations are provided in two phases. Phase I does not require construction and can be implemented much sooner through the addition of signage and pavement markings. Phase 2 requires roadway construction and therefore will need to be implemented in stages. A copy of the Presentation may be found below.

Vanderbilt Traffic Calming Presentation 2nd Workshop 4-9-2015

In May 2014 the City of Doral mailed out 206 ballots to all the residents that live within the Vanderbilt Park community and the City received 84 completed ballots. From those ballots received, the Vanderbilt Park Community that voted 74% are in favor for Phase I improvements and 26% are not in favor of the Phase I improvements. Similarly, from those ballots received, the Vanderbilt Park Community that voted 72% are in favor for Phase 2 improvements and 28% are not in favor of the Phase 2 improvements. Miami-Dade County requires that two-thirds (2/3) of the community agree with the proposed improvements prior to installation. The results of the ballots are provided below.
