A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA REMOVING ALL CONDITIONS SET FORTH PURSUANT TO MIAMI-DADE RESOLUTION CZAB9-25-98 AND RELEASING DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE **COVENANTS** RECORDED IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OFFICIAL RECORDS, **BOOK 18203, PAGE 2443 FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT** 2500 NW 87<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, DORAL, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR RECORDATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Applicant, Sunshine Gasoline Distributors Inc, has requested to remove all conditions set forth pursuant of Miami-Dade County Resolution CZAB9-25-98 and to release from the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants as recorded in the Miami-Dade County Official Records, Book 18203, Page 2443; and

WHEREAS, the requested modification would allow the property being operated at 2500 NW 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Doral, Florida to be developed consistent with the property's zoning district of Corridor Commercial:
