

RESOLUTION NO. 13-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HARDESTY & HANOVER, LLC., TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ODOR MONITORING PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,672.21; RECOGNIZING THAT HARDESTY & HANOVER, LLC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE (PUBLIC WORKS)

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Public Works Department wishes to secure a firm to perform random field monitoring, on-call field monitoring, correlation of data, and response and reporting services, that is consistent with, and helps implement, the City's Odor Monitoring Plan; and

WHEREAS, Hardesty & Hanover, LLC., is a prequalified provider of professional services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in September 2011. Following a review of the experience and qualifications for the pool of prequalified firms, it was determined that Hardesty & Hanover, LLC., has relevant experience to assist the City with the implementation of the City's Odor Monitoring Plan; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to direct Hardesty & Hanover, LLC., to perform the necessary work to implement the City's Odor Monitoring Plan; in an amount not to exceed \$28,672.21.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Authorization. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Hardesty & Hanover, LLC., to perform random field monitoring, on-call field monitoring, correlation of

data, and response and reporting services, that is consistent with, and helps implement, the City's Odor Monitoring Plan, in an amount not to exceed \$28,672.21.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
