A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE PUBLICLY BID STATE OF FLORIDA CONTRACT WITH KONICA-MINOLTA AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH KONICA-MINOLTA FOR THE PROVISION OF COPIER SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,542.12; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City is currently under a contract with Canon for six (6) copiers for an annual cost of \$26,629.56; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has a contract for copier services with Konica-Minolta which, if adopted by the City of Doral, would save the city approximately \$7,087.44 per year; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council adopt the publicly bid State of Florida contract with Konica-Minolta for the provision of copier services and authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a lease agreement with Konica-Minolta for the provision of copier services in an amount not to exceed \$19,542.12 per year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby adopts the publicly bid State of Florida contract with Konica-Minolta for the provision of copier services and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a lease agreement with Konica-Minolta for the provision of copier services in an amount not to exceed \$19,542.12 per year.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
