

ORDINANCE 2012-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY CHANGING THE LAND USE DESIGNATION FROM INSTITUTIONAL AND PUBLIC FACILITY TO OFFICE / RESIDENTIAL FOR APPROXIMATELY 28 ACRES LOCATED AT 9100 NW 36TH STREET, DORAL, FLORIDA; AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSMITTAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATION ACT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has been designated as the Local Planning Agency ("LPA") for the City pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, and has held a duly advertised public hearing and recommended approval of Hearing No. 12-01-DOR-03 to amend the Comprehensive Development Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral has conducted duly advertised public hearings upon the future land use proposed by Hearing No. 12-01-DOR-03 and has considered all comments received concerning the proposed amendment to the Plan as required by state law and local ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed City staff's proposal, incorporated herein, which contains data involving and analysis supporting the text amendments and future land use change; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed amendments are consistent with the City's Comprehensive Development Master Plan and supported by staff and the LPA, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL,
FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the City's Comprehensive Development Master Plan is amended to change the future land use map for approximately 28± acres located at 9100 NW 36th Street, Doral, Florida , from Institutional and Public Facility to Office/Residential, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Planning and Zoning Director is further authorized to make the necessary Map changes as required to the Comprehensive Development Master Plan to reflect the above stated change.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not become effective until the State Land Planning Agency issues a Final Order determining the adopted amendment to be in compliance and in accordance with Section 163.3184(9), Florida Statutes, or until the Administration Commission issues a Final Order determining the adopted amendment to be in compliance in accordance with Section 163.3184(10), Florida Statutes.

The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Councilmember Rodriguez, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Boria and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
