

**RESOLUTION No. 23-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH H&J ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF ROADWAY RESTORATION AND STRIPING AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF NW 58 STREET AND NW 82 AVENUE, AND NW 34 STREET AND NW 117 AVENUE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,528.50; WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES; RECOGNIZING THAT H&J ASPHALT, INC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, on June 14, 2022, the existing contract for “Milling, Resurfacing and Miscellaneous Stormwater and Roadway Improvement” (ITB-2019-12) expired; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department (PWD) proceeded to fragment the all-encompassing scope of work of previous contract to its new format of three (3) “scope specific” areas of construction; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 21, 2022, Request for Qualification (RFQ) No. 2022-13 “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” was issued and advertised on the City’s Website; and

**WHEREAS**, a recommendation was made by the committee to award the top four (4) ranked firms, H&J Asphalt, Inc., H&R Paving, Inc., Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., and General Asphalt, establishing a Pool of Construction Firms for “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services”; and

**WHEREAS**, the PWD needs to secure a firm to provide roadway restoration and striping at the intersections of NW 58<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and at NW 34<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the PWD requested a proposal from the pre-qualified pool of contractors for “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services”; and

**WHEREAS**, H&J Asphalt provided attached proposal and was deemed the lowest bid proposal with a not to exceed amount of \$17,528.50 which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen.; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract between H&J Asphalt, Inc., and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Request for Qualification (RFQ) 2022-13 process to select a pool of pre-qualified Construction Services firms for “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” projects; and

**WHEREAS**, this group of four (4) firms was approved by the City Council during the August 2022 Council meeting via Resolution No. 22-144; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 3 for H&J Asphalt Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, for the provision to provide roadway restoration and striping at the intersections of NW 58<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and at NW 34<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$17,528.50 which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this request is available in the Public Works CITT Fund – “Improvements Street” Account, Account Num. 106.80005.500633.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

**Section 2. Approval.** Work Order No. 3 to H&J Asphalt, Inc. for roadway restoration and striping at the intersections of NW 58<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and at NW 34<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$17,528.50 which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the Interim City Attorney, is hereby approved.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

**Section 4. Implementation.** The City Manager and the Interim City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Puig-Corve who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Pineyro and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
