

**RESOLUTION No. 21-55**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARING INVITATION TO BID #2020-35 “TRAILS AND TAILS PARK LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS” TO HORSEPOWER ELECTRIC, INC. THE LOWEST, MOST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND HORSEPOWER ELECTRIC, INC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FUNDING ALLOCATED WITHIN THE GENERAL OBLIGATION PARKS BOND ESTIMATED AT \$675,000.00 FOR THE TRAILS AND TAILS LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEXT QUALIFIED FIRM SUCCESSIVELY IF AN AGREEMENT CAN NOT BE NEGOTIATED WITH THE TOP RANKED FIRM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND EXPEND ALLOCATED FUNDING FROM WITHIN THE GENERAL OBLIGATION PARKS BOND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Trails and Tails Park improvements will include the addition of a lighting system for the parking area, the two dog parks, and along the existing Greenway Trail, and the existing restroom building office space will also be modified for the addition of a secured IT room; and

**WHEREAS**, On November 6, 2018, City of Doral voters approved the Parks Bond Referendum providing the City with the funding mechanism needed to proceed with the design, permitting, and construction of the projects outlined in the bond. The Downtown Doral Cultural Center is one of the projects as part of the Bond Referendum; and

**WHEREAS**, the City issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) #2020-35, “Trails and Tails Park Lighting Improvements” (the “ITB”), for which the City received five (5) submittals and were opened on January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 with all other firms meeting the required criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review of bids received, staff determined that Horsepower Electric, Inc was the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder (the “Contractor”); and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of Contractor’s Bid Submittal which includes the Construction Contract, RFP #2020-35 Inventory, and Bid Tabulation are all attached as Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that accepting the bid and entering into a contract for the Project with the Contractor for the quoted price as submitted in the Contractor’s proposal dated January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021, plus contingency for any unforeseen conditions, is in the best interest of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, funds for these services will be allocated from the Park Bond Fund in Fiscal Year 2020-21 in account number 303.9000572.500650; and

**WHEREAS**, the awarded Contractor shall adhere to the budget provided in the RFQ and the pricing submitted by said firm(s) on January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 during negotiations with the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City reserves the right to commence negotiations with the next highest ranked firm if the Contractor and the City cannot agree on terms and pricing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

**Section 2. Approval.** The contract between the City and Horsepower Electric, Inc. for the Project together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. In no event shall the project exceed the bid amount submitted plus contingency funded as allocated within the General Obligation Parks Bond.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to execute the construction contract and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

**Section 4. Implementation.** The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



Subject: **Award Recommendation for ITB No. 2020-35 Trails and Tails Park Construction**

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### Introduction

The City Manager's Office respectfully request that the Mayor and City Council-Members award the ITB No. 2020-35 to the lowest bidder. The project consists of the construction of the Trails and Tails Park located at 11645 NW 50<sup>th</sup> Street, Doral, FL.

### Background

Since 2003, when the City was incorporated, the Mayor and City Council-Members have envisioned world-class parks with many amenities that would be multi-generational, multi-purpose and multi-seasonal. The City is working proactively to help provide additional parks, facilities, and amenities to meet the needs of both current and future residents. A key goal is for all residents of the city to be within walking distance of a "walk-to" or neighborhood park, that meets the recreational needs of residents of all ages, interests and capabilities.

The recent park system master planning process completed in 2017 validated that Doral has a proven reputation for providing high-quality parks, amenities, and experiences, however, struggles to meet the demands of a rapidly growing population in a landlocked geography. As noted in both the 2010 and 2017 Doral Parks System Master Plans, the City is perpetually playing "catch up", resulting in parks which can become over-used, over-programmed, and inflexible.

The City of Doral is currently "underparked," based on state and national benchmarks as well as comparisons to similar cities. While the City's comprehensive plan establishes a level-of-service (LOS) goal of 4.5 acres of parkland per 1,000 population, the actual LOS is 1.85 acres per thousand. If no additional parkland is acquired, the LOS will decline to approximately 1.5 acres /1,000 by the year 2025

when the City's population is estimated to exceed 90,000 residents. When a park systems level of service decreases, so does the city's quality of life.

The City of Doral has a proven history of providing high-quality parks and public spaces, which when combined with Doral's active and social population, result in high levels of usage. While positive, this increased level of consistent activation also results in an increased level of wear and tear on the equipment and facilities at existing park sites. With Doral's population projected to continue increasing into the foreseeable future, strategic improvements to existing parks and facilities will be necessary to maintain the quality of experience that Doral residents have come to expect. Many of these improvements will be focused on increasing the usability, accessibility, and most importantly, the safety, of Doral's existing park sites.

On November 6, 2018, the General Obligation Parks Bond (Parks Bond) for \$150 million was passed. This bond will help fund the construction of high-priority park projects. The Mayor, City Council, and administrative team have turned their attention to establishing the safeguards that will guide the City's use of the bond funds, including establishing the audit oversight committee, preparing project plans, and providing the residents with regular progress reports.

The proposed improvements to Tails and Tails Park will include a new lighting within the park, playground and along the trail. Additionally, improvements to the office and IT rooms within the building on-site will be included.

Horsepower Electric, Inc. is a family owned and operated, full services electrical contractor and general contractor qualified to handle any size project from start to finish. Family owned and operated means service you can count on from people who care. The company was founded in 1985 in Miami Florida by Hector Ortiz. The company has been involved in all aspects of electrical design, installations, and maintenance. Over the years, Horsepower Electric has had the opportunity to proudly partake in many high-profile projects. Horsepower Electric has built a reputation for being able to complete the most challenging electrical construction projects. Many of these projects resulted in lasting relationships with owners, clients, and subcontractors and are still in existence today.

### **Procurement**

ITB# 2020-35 was issued on December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 for the purpose of a certified General Contractor for the construction and improvements at Trails and Tails Park. The Bid was advertised on DemandStar and the City's Web Site. Sixteen (16) firms attended the Pre-bid Meeting held on January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Five (5) submittals were received and opened on January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 with all five (5) meeting the required criteria. Below please find a list of the proposal received:

### **Recommendation**

The City Manager Office requests that the Mayor and City Council-Members award ITB #2020-35 "Trails and Tails Park Lighting Improvements" to HPE and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with HPE to provide the desired services for the project in an amount not to exceed funding allocated within the General Obligation Parks Bond. If an agreement cannot be reached with the number one proposer, the negotiations will proceed to the next ranked firm until an agreement is reached.

Funds for these services will be allocated from the Park Bond Fund estimated not to exceed \$675,000 (including contingency) in Fiscal Year 2020-21 in account number 303.90005.500650.

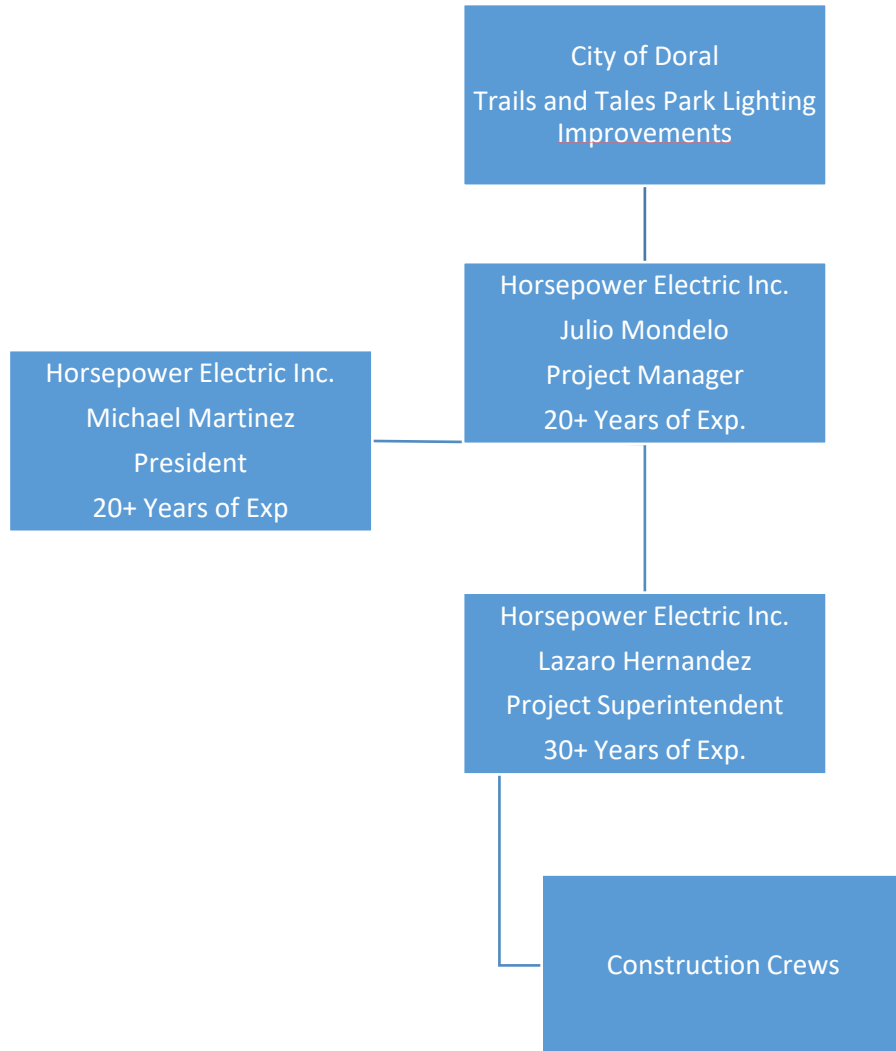
