

RESOLUTION No. 18-146

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING AND ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE AND LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF 1.9000 MILLS, WHICH IS 5.42% HIGHER THAN THE ROLL-BACK RATE, TO BALANCE THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019; ESTABLISHING THE ROLLED BACK RATE TO BE 1.8023 MILLS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, *Florida Statutes* the City of Doral, Florida (the "City") has established a proposed millage rate; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2018, the City Council held a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage rate, to adopt a tentative millage rate, and to adopt a tentative operating budget for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 ("FY 2018-2019"), in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(c), *Florida Statutes* and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2018, the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider any adjustment of its tentative millage rate, to adopt a final millage rate, confirm its rolled-back rate and to adopt a final operating budget for FY 2018-2019, in accordance with Section 200.065(2)(d), *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral establishes, pursuant to State law, a final millage rate to balance the budget for the General Fund for FY 2018-2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Tentative Millage Rate. The City establishes a tentative millage rate of \$1.9000 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value within the City of Doral, to balance the budget for FY 2018-2019.

Section 3. Rolled-Back Rate. The City further confirms the rolled-back rate for FY 2018-2019 to be 1.8023 mills and the millage rate of 1.9000 mills, which is 5.42% more than the rolled back rate.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager, City Clerk, and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Rodriguez and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
