

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO WORK ORDER NO. 6 BETWEEN
THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA
AND
DAVID PLUMMER AND ASSOCIATES**

This First Amendment to David Plummer & Associates Work Order No. 6 made and entered into this 13 day of December, 2017, by and between the City of Doral, Florida, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida ("City") and David Plummer and Associates. ("Consultant") having its place of business at 1750 Ponce de Leon Boulevard, Coral Gables, FL 33134, for the provision of Design Services for Traffic Calming Improvements Project in Vanderbilt Park Community.

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently engaged in the design of traffic calming improvements at Vanderbilt Park Community; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has conducted multiple reviews on the proposed design plans and provided multiple rounds of comments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently contracted with David Plummer and Associates (DPA) for the design of traffic calming improvements within the Vanderbilt Park Community and due to the extensive Miami-Dade County reviews and comments provided DPA has provided additional work that was not anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the original cost for the design services for the traffic calming improvements within Vanderbilt Park Community approved by the Work Order was a not to exceed amount of \$59,200.00; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the provision of additional work performed for the design services was increased to a not exceed amount of \$13,450.00 for the addition of the design services for the traffic calming improvements, with the cost of the amended work to be a not to exceed amount of \$72,650.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in this First Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Amendments. The following Sections of the Work Order are hereby amended to read as follows:


"SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:

...The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and material basis with a not to exceed amount of ~~\$59,200.00~~ \$72,650.00."

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN, all other terms and conditions of the Contract dated June 8, 2016, remain in full force and effect.

RESOLUTION No. 17-226

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND WORK ORDER No. 6 WITH DAVID PLUMMER AND ASSOCIATES FOR THE DESIGN OF TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE VANDERBILT PARK COMMUNITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,450.00 FOR AN AMENDED NOT TO EXCEED TOTAL OF \$72,650.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") is presently engaged in the design of traffic calming improvements in the Vanderbilt Park Community; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County (the "County") has conducted multiple reviews on the proposed design plans and provided multiple rounds of comments; and

WHEREAS, the City has a current contract with David Plummer and Associates ("DPA") for the design of traffic calming improvements within the Vanderbilt Park Community and, due to the extensive effort that has been required to address the County's comments, DPA has exhausted their budget and submitted a request for a supplemental to their Work Order; and

WHEREAS, the original cost for the design services for the traffic calming improvements within Vanderbilt Park Community approved by the Work Order was a not to exceed amount of \$59,200.00; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the additional work needed to complete the design and permitting for the project was negotiated in a not to exceed amount of \$13,450.00 for a new not to exceed amount of \$72,650; and

WHEREAS, the staff has recommended that the City Council the foregoing increase to the work order in order to complete the work timely.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval. The work order amendment with David Plummer & Associates for the additional design services required to complete the design and permitting for the Vanderbilt Traffic Calming Improvements in the amount of \$13,450.00, for a total Work Order not to exceed amount of \$72,650.00, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved. Funding will come from account # 101.80005.500650.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order amendment with David Plummer & Associates and expend budgeted funds on the behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
