

RESOLUTION NO. 06-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A WORK AUTHORIZATION TO LEISURE GRANTS SERVICES, INC. FOR THE PREPARATION OF A LAND ACQUISITION GRANT APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on December 14TH, 2005 the City Council of the City of Doral adopted Resolution #05-87 approving an agreement with Leisure Grants Services, Inc. to provide grants management services for the City of Doral; and

WHEREAS, Leisure Grants Services, Inc. has prepared six Florida Forever Program Grant Applications in the past three years and has a 100% success rate, providing \$13,770,204 of funding to their clients; and

WHEREAS, Leisure Grants Services seeks to prepare a land acquisition grant application that would provide funding in the approximate amount of \$5,025,000.00 for the purchase of 10 acres of park land; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a Work Authorization to Leisure Grants Services, Inc., for the preparation of a grant application for the Florida Forever Program Grant Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a work authorization to Leisure Grants Services, Inc. for the preparation of a grant application for the Florida Forever Program Grant Program.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


