

RESOLUTION NO. 06-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A WORK AUTHORIZATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF "NO PARKING" SIGNS ALONG A PORTION OF N.W. 109TH AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2005, a site observation determined several vehicles parked during the AM peak hours in the swale area of N.W. 109th Avenue from N.W. 58th Street south of the Imperial Village at Doral Grand Condominium; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles caused a site triangle obstruction at the exit of the Doral Grand Condominiums. Additional site observations determined several more vehicles parked along the area during the PM peak hours; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the safety of the residents and motorists, staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a work authorization for the installation of "No Parking" signs along the portion of N.W. 109th avenue described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a work authorization for the installation of "No Parking" signs along a portion of N.W. 109th Avenue approves the modifications to the Master Plan for Doral Park as specified above.


