

RESOLUTION NO. 04-54

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING JUNE 11, 2004 AS NATIONAL SMALL CITIES AND TOWNS DAY, AND ENCOURAGING ALL CITIZENS TO SUPPORT THE CELEBRATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, approximately 95% of all municipalities in the country are small towns and cities; and

WHEREAS, municipal government is the government closest to most citizens and the one with the most direct daily impact upon its residents; and

WHEREAS, National Small Cities and Towns Day is an initiative spearheaded by the National League of Cities to highlight the challenges facing small cities; and

WHEREAS, the National League of Cities helps small towns forge partnerships with the federal government,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Doral encourages all citizens, municipal government officials and employees to do everything possible to ensure that this day is recognized and celebrated accordingly.

Section 2. That the City of Doral does support and encourage all municipal governments to actively promote National Small Cities and Towns Day.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilwoman Ruiz, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman DiPietro and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


