

1 WHEREAS, subsequent to filing its Motion to Intervene, the Town of Medley,
2 through its Mayor and Town Attorney, requested that the City of Doral refrain from its
3 attempt to intervene in the lawsuit as the Town of Medley was engaged in settlement
4 discussions with Waste Management, Inc.; and

5 WHEREAS, based on the representations of the Town of Medley, through its
6 Town Attorney and others, that it would ensure that the City of Doral's interests would
7 be considered during its negotiations, the City of Doral agreed to refrain from its
8 attempts to intervene and to support the Town of Medley's position; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Doral has recently learned that a proposed
10 Development Agreement is to be considered by the Town of Medley at its Commission
11 meeting of September 19, 2005; and

12 WHEREAS, a review of the proposed Development Agreement reveals that no
13 attempts whatsoever were made to notify the City of Doral of this action or to consider
14 the interests of Doral and the effects of the expansion of the Landfill on Doral; and

15 WHEREAS, no attempts were made despite the recent assurance of Medley
16 that they would provide the City of Doral with an opportunity to provide input into any
17 proposed settlement or agreement entered into by the Town of Medley with Waste
18 Management;

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
2 **THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA THAT:**

3 **Section 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and
4 confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution upon
5 adoption hereof.

6 **Section 2.** The City of Doral hereby objects to the Town of Medley
7 entering into a Development Agreement with Waste Management, Inc. of Florida as
8 the Agreement was done without seeking input from Doral and fails to address the
9 concerns and issues raised by the City of Doral. Further, the City of Doral expressly
10 requests that the Town of Medley defer considering entering into a Development
11 Agreement with Waste Management, Inc. of Florida concerning the Landfill until the
12 City of Doral has had an opportunity to have its concerns addressed.

13 **Section 3.** This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and
14 adoption by the City Council.

15 WHEREAS, a motion to approve the Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor
16 Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman DiPietro
17 and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

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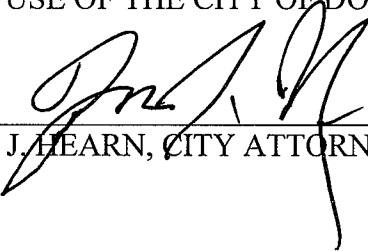
