## **RESOLUTION No. 09 – 47**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GARDEN STATE FIREWORKS FOR THE PROVISION OF FIREWORKS DISPLAYS FOR THE CITY'S FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATION WITH THE OPTION OF THREE (3), ONE (1) YEAR RENEWAL PERIODS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PYROTECNICO, INC., IN THE EVENT AN AGREEMENT WITH GARDEN STATE FIREWORKS CANNOT BE SUCCESSFULLY NEGOTIATED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to provide its residents with a top-rate fireworks display for its Fourth of July Celebration; and

WHEREAS, in response to RFP 2009-03 titled "Fireworks Displays," the City of Doral received four (4) proposals by the March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009 11:00 a.m. deadline; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Garden State Fireworks for the provision of fireworks displays for the City's Fourth of July celebration with the option of three (3), one (1) year renewal periods; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Pyrotecnico, Inc. in the event an agreement with Garden State Fireworks cannot be successfully negotiated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Garden State Fireworks for the provision of fireworks displays for the City's Fourth of July celebration with the option of

three (3), one (1) year renewal periods.

**Section 2**. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Pyrotecnico, Inc. in the event an agreement with Garden State Fireworks cannot be successfully negotiated.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
