

RESOLUTION No. 08 – 130

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 2010 FORD ESCAPE VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,972.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has budgeted for the purchase of a new Ford Escape hybrid vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the cost of a conventional gasoline engine 2010 Ford Escape is \$15,486.00 as compared to the cost of the hybrid which is approximately \$28,000.00; and

WHEREAS, although it would be preferable to purchase a hybrid vehicle in keeping consistent with the City's efforts on green initiatives, advances in emission controls have produced a gasoline engine that will emit no more harmful pollution than a hybrid; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to purchase two (2) 2010 Ford Escape vehicles for the use of the Public Works Department in an amount not to exceed \$30,972.00 which represents an additional \$2,732 over the budgeted amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to purchase two (2) 2010 Ford Escape vehicles for the use of the Public Works Department in an amount not to exceed \$30,972.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Councilman Van Name who moved its adoption.
