

RESOLUTION Z09-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ROAD CLOSURE OF NW 113TH COURT FROM NW 74TH TERRACE TO NW 74TH STREET, DORAL, FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Polynesian at Island at Doral Neighborhood Association, Inc., ("Applicant") has requested approval to close NW 113th Court from NW 74th Terrace to NW 74th Street, Doral, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2009, the City Council held a public hearing and after careful review and deliberation, including a review of staff's recommendation, determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Doral to approve the road closure, subject to conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby approves Applicant's request to close NW 113th Court from NW 74th Terrace to NW 74th Street, Doral, Florida; is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall obtain approval from Miami-Dade County.
2. The applicant shall submit engineering plans, showing the closure, to the City's Public Works Department for review and approval.
3. The southern 18 feet of the road must be dedicated.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida and the Applicant shall pay the costs of recording said document.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council.

A motion to approve the Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor DiPietro , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman Van Name and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
