4. Discussion Items

a. PZAD-2306-0252 - Doral Central Park – 3005 NW 92 AVE, Doral, FL, 33166

- Scott Bakos, Bermello Ajamil & Partner, presents application to board and provides an explanation of the public art for Doral Central Park.
- Board member, Rodolfo de Athayde, suggested that the proposed structures be outfitted with easily integrated lighting & sound elements to be used by a variety of events at the location. Mr. Bakos explained that the structure is indeed outfitted with easily accessible sound & lighting installation.
- Public Art Committee voted unanimously (4-0) to transmit the application for the public art at Doral Central Park to Mayor and Council for consideration and approval. Item will be placed on the September 13, 2023 council meeting.

b. PZAD-2202-0008 - Federal Reserve Bank - 9100 NW 36 ST, Doral, FL 33166.

- Michael Young, Director of Planning & Construction, presents application to board and provides an explanation of the public art for or the Federal Reserve Bank.
- Board member, Jane Decker, asked if this existing piece of art was brought to the City Attorney for a determination as to whether existing art can be considered for the Public Art Program requirement.
- Board member, Rodolfo de Athayde, suggested that the public art be made more accessible to the public.
- Public Art Committee voted unanimously (4-0) with the condition that the City Attorney agrees that an existing art piece can be used to satisfy the Public Art requirement. The application will be transmitted to Mayor and Council for consideration and approval. Item will be placed on a council meeting date to be determined pending legal review.

c. PZAD-2306-0256 - McDonald's Corp- 7570 NW 104 AVE, Doral, FL 33178

- Gabriella Buttress & Christy Del Sol, Loud & Live Marketing, presents application to board and provides an explanation of the proposed mural for the McDonalds Corp. location.
- Board member, Jane Decker, asked if this proposed art installation could have been approved administratively as this proposed mural is being presented as a courtesy and not as a requirement to the Public Art Program.
