

RESOLUTION No. 16-135

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND DAVID PLUMMER & ASSOCIATES, A PREQUALIFIED CITY VENDOR, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR THE TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES AT THE VANDERBILT PARK COMMUNITY (PHASE 2) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$59,200.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the “City”) completed a Traffic Calming Study for the Vanderbilt Park Community and developed mitigation improvements for implementation in two Phases (Phase 1 and Phase 2); and

WHEREAS, the City mailed ballots to all the Vanderbilt Park residents to vote on the recommended Phase 1 and Phase 2 traffic calming improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City received the necessary two-thirds (2/3) votes from the Vanderbilt Park residents in favor of having the City implement the recommended Phase 1 and Phase 2 improvements; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 traffic calming improvements were completed in August of 2015 and consisted of turn restriction signs, pavement markings, and replacement and installation of reduced speed limit signs; and

WHEREAS, David Plummer & Associates is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with the requirements of Florida’s Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act and the City’s Procurement Code and approved by the City Council in December 2014; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the Mayor and City Council approve the Work Order with David Plummer & Associates, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the provision of design services for the Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Improvements (Phase 2) in and amount not to exceed \$59,200.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Work Order No. 6 for design services for the Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Improvements (Phase 2) in an amount not to exceed \$59,200.00, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Work Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Ruiz who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cabrera and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of David Plummer & Associates to proceed with the provision of professional services for the development of construction plans for the traffic calming devices at the Vanderbilt Park Community (Phase 2) as of the date of this Work Order. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between David Plummer & Associates and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2015, and the attached Proposal submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from David Plummer & Associates dated November 2, 2015 (Revised May 11, 2016) and the schedule requires that the work be completed within 90 calendar days. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and materials basis with a not to exceed amount of \$59,200.00.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 2, 2015 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.
