

RESOLUTION NO. 12 – 148

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HUB CITY FORD MERCURY, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2013 F-150 VEHICLE FOR THE USE OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000.00; RECOGNIZING THAT THIS AGREEMENT IS BASED ON THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN HUB CITY FORD MERCURY, INC AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V OF THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Parks and Recreation Department has budgeted the purchase of one (1) 2013 F-150 Vehicle to meet the increased demands of the two new parks and bikeways in the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Hub City Ford Mercury, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) 2013 F-150 vehicle for the use of the Parks and Recreation Department in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Staff further requests that the City Council recognize that this agreement is based on the existing agreement between Hub City Ford Mercury, Inc. and the State of Florida which was competitively entered into a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Hub City Ford Mercury, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) 2013 F-150 vehicle for the use of the Parks and Recreation Department in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00.

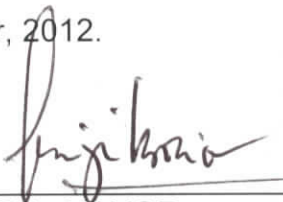
