## RESOLUTION No. 09 - 66

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A CITY-INITIATED CHANGE ORDER TO THE EXISTING CONTRACT WITH WILLIAMS PAVING, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL ASPHALT FOR N.W. 82ND AVENUE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is undergoing the reconstruction of N.W. 82<sup>nd</sup>

Avenue from N.W. 12<sup>th</sup> Street to N.W. 25<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, in November 2008, the City Council awarded a contract to Williams Paving, Inc. for the reconstruction of N.W. 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue; and

WHEREAS, multiple construction-related issues, including the discovery that additional asphalt is needed to extend the useful life of this road, were discovered during construction that were not contemplated in the original contract and that have impacted the cost of construction; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to issue a city-initiated change order to the existing contract with Williams Paving, Inc. for the provision of additional asphalt for N.W. 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to issue a city-initiated change order to the existing contract with Williams Paving, Inc. for the provision of additional asphalt for N.W. 82<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00.
