WHEREAS; Doral Farmers' Market and EcoTem Inc. ("Applicants") seek approval from the City of Doral for Farmers' Market; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully recommends that Council approve the proposed Farmers' Market for to be held at 10311 NW 58 Street Doral, Florida, on Saturday's from October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 to February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm:

- Construction plans for tents (larger than 10 X 10) and any structural facility must be submitted to the Building Department for approval.
- Applicant shall obtain electrical permit for the generator if required by the Building Department.
- 3. All City and State Licenses must be obtained prior to the opening of the Market.
- All trash and refuse must be must be removed from the site at the end of each day.
- 5. If safety and traffic circulation become problematic according to the City of Doral Police, the Farmers' Market shall coordinate and hire officers and/or or secure private security in a manner satisfactory with the City of Doral Police.
- 6. Based on the number of parking spaces, the maximum number of vendors is limited to 25. However, Staff may approve additional vendors based on staff analysis of the site's parking utilization and circulation for the market.

7. Lighting must be provided during morning set up prior to sunrise.
