

RESOLUTION No. 10 – 170

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW THE SUBSCRIPTION TO THE CODERED WEATHER WARNING SERVICE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,500.00 ANNUALLY FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in October of 2010, the City renewed its subscription for the CodeRed Emergency Communication Service for the purpose of alerting our citizens to critical events and information at an annual cost of \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to renew the CodeRed Weather Warning Service at an additional annual cost of \$7,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the CodeRed Weather Warning Service automatically alerts Doral residents who subscribe to the service and whose residences are directly in the projected path of any severe weather; and

WHEREAS, the CodeRed Weather Warning Service module interacts and shares databases with the CodeRed Emergency Communication Service, thus making CodeRed the sole source for this interactive product; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing and Procurement Ordinance #2004-03, Sec. 12-9, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the competitive procurement requirements and authorize the City Manager to renew the subscription to the CodeRed Weather Warning Service in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00 annually for a period of three (3) years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby waives the competitive procurement requirements and authorizes the City Manager to renew the subscription to the CodeRed Weather Warning Service in an amount not to exceed \$7,500.00 annually for a period of three (3) years.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Councilman Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor DiPietro and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
