The City of Doral authorizes the firm of Miliani Construction Corp, Inc. to proceed with the provision of Construction Services for Corsica Phase 2 Sidewalk Repairs. Where Miliani Construction Corp, Inc. is a pre-qualified provider of Construction Services selected in accordance with RFQ 2022-12 requirements and approved by the City Council on August 9, 2022, through Resolution 22-143. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Construction Services Agreement between Miliani Construction Corp, Inc. and the City of Doral dated August 9, 2022, and the attached Proposal submitted on February 13, 2023, submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from Miliani Construction Corp, Inc. submitted on February 13, 2023. The schedule requires the work to be performed within 30 calendar days from NTP. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed based on the schedule of values submitted by Miliani Construction Corp, Inc. with a not to exceed amount of \$61,146.80, which includes a 10% contingency amount for any unforeseen conditions.

You are required by the Continuing Construction Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award. Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Construction Agreement dated August 9, 2022, between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Construction Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

This Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in two (2) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.

RESOLUTION No. 23-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH MILIANI CONSTRUCTION CORP FOR THE PROVISION OF SIDEWALK, CURB & GUTTER AND MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE REPAIRS ALONG CORSICA PHASE 2 AREA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$61,146.80; WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES; RECOGNIZING THAT MILIANI CONSTRUCTION CORP IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2022, the City of Doral ("City") issued and advertised Request for Qualification No. 2022-12 "Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter and Miscellaneous Concrete Repair Services" ("RFQ"); and

WHEREAS, an evaluation committee was convened and made a recommendation to the City Council to award the RFQ to the top three (3) ranked firms, The American Design Engineering Construction Inc., GPE Engineering & General Contractor Corp., and Miliani Construction Corp., and to establish a pool of construction firms for "Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter and Miscellaneous Concrete Repair Services"; and

WHEREAS, this group of three (3) firms was approved by the City Council during the August 2022 Council meeting via Resolution No. 22-143; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department ("PWD") is now in need of a firm to provide sidewalk, curb, gutter and other miscellaneous concrete repair services along the Corsica Phase 2 Area ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from the pre-qualified pool of contractors to provide the Services; and

WHEREAS, Miliani Construction Corp., provided the attached proposal and was deemed the lowest bidder with a not to exceed amount of \$61,146.80, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the contract between Miliani Construction Corp., and the City was procured through the aforementioned RFQ; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 4 with Miliani Construction Corp., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the provision of sidewalk, curb, gutter and other miscellaneous concrete repair services along the Corsica Phase 2 Area in an amount not to exceed \$61,146.80, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available from Transportation Fund – "Improvements Street" Account, Account Num. 001.80005.500633.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Work Order No. 4 with Miliani Construction Corp, for Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter and Miscellaneous Concrete Repair Services along Corsica Phase 2, in an amount not to exceed \$61,146.80, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", together

with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
