The City of Doral authorizes the firm of BCC Engineering, LLC to provide professional engineering design services for the provision of developing the City of Doral Watershed Master Planning (WMP). Where BCC Engineering, Inc. is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in October 2020 through Resolution 20-243. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between BCC Engineering, LLC and the City of Doral dated January 4, 2021, and the attached Proposal dated February 19, 2021 and submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:**

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from BCC Engineering, LLC dated February 19, 2021 to develop the City of Doral WMP. The schedule requires the scope of work to be completed within 7 months of NTP. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and material basis not to exceed the amount of \$98,923.30.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated January 4, 2021 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.

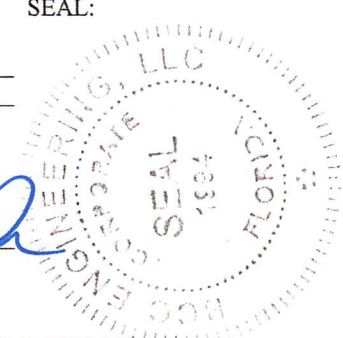

**RESOLUTION No. 21-99**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A WORK ORDER WITH BCC ENGINEERING TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES TO DEVELOP THE CITY OF DORAL WATERSHED MASTER PLAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,923.30; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, A Watershed Master Plan (WMP) is developed and implemented to analyze the combined effects of the existing and expected development and redevelopment on drainage throughout the watershed and includes a plan of action to address current and expected problems; and

**WHEREAS**, the flood peak at a point downstream in a watershed is a result of both the quantity of upstream runoff and the time it takes for water to travel down the watershed; and

**WHEREAS**, the objective of this WMP is to provide the community with a tool it can use to make decisions that will reduce the increased flooding from the development on a watershed-wide basis and address existing flood problems; and

**WHEREAS**, the WMP allows communities within the watershed to consider future development as they work on current problems and ensure that future development does not aggravate existing conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of a WMP will follow the City's strategic goal of "Quality of Place", ensuring that adequate infrastructure is in place to help prevent flooding; and

**WHEREAS**, the PWD has completed the update for the 2020 Stormwater Master

Plan (SMP) and 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and is presenting the SMP and the included CIP to the Mayor and City Council-Members at the April 2021 Council Meeting for Council adoption; and

**WHEREAS**, the PWD requested a proposal from BCC Engineering for the development of the WMP, and BCC provided the attached proposal on a time and material basis with a not to exceed amount of \$98,923.30; and

**WHEREAS**, it should be noted that data collected for the SMP will be used to develop the City's WMP; and

**WHEREAS**, it should also be noted that in addition of being a planning tool, the WMP can help the City with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Community Rating System (CRS) by providing necessary points to improve the classification of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends that the City Council approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the work order with BCC; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this request is available from Fiscal Year 2020-21 in the Public Works Stormwater Fund – Professional Service Account, Account No. 401.80005.500314.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

**Section 2. Approval.** The Work Order between the City of Doral and BCC Engineering to provide professional services to develop the City of Doral Watershed Master Planning (WMP), in an amount not to exceed of \$98,923.30, a copy which is

attached as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to execute the Work Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

**Section 4. Implementation.** The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
