

RESOLUTION No. 16-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN OUTDOOR EVENT PERMIT FOR CHEVY'S RESTAURANT MIAMI TO HOST THE "CINCO DE MAYO" EVENT AT CHEVY'S RESTAURANT MIAMI, LOCATED AT 8191 NW 12th STREET, ON THURSDAY, MAY 5, 2016; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Chevy's Restaurant Miami ("Applicant") seeks approval from the City of Doral for an Outdoor Event Permit as per the information submitted in the application and corresponding information, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that Council approve the Applicant's proposed Outdoor Event Permit to host the "Cinco de Mayo" event on Thursday, May 5, 2016 at Chevy's Restaurant Miami located at 8191 NW 12th Street, Doral, Florida, 33126.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval. The outdoor event permit for the "Cinco de Mayo" event is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

1. The comments made by the City of Doral Police Department, as found in Exhibit "B";
2. The payments of costs found in Exhibit "C"
3. The acquisition of all required permits, and the performance of all necessary inspections prior to event start, required by the City of Doral Building Department.

All attachments are incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Chevys has been hosting Cinco de Mayo fiesta since 1996. We have become the number one destination for this great cultural event. We are committed to organizing a fun and safe event for all our patrons and guests.

The following information and measures are going to be taken to insure a successful and safe event:

1. Security- we have contracted City of Doral ~~Miami-Dade~~ police to provide security for the event. A total of 5 police officers with one sergeant will be securing the event. In addition a team of 6 private security personnel will assist in the security and organization of the event.
2. Restrooms- We are renting twelve portable toilets plus two handicap toilets
3. Master of Ceremonies- We will utilize the services of a professional master of ceremonies to coordinate safety, responsible drinking and directing crowd and also insuring guests are parking in the proper areas.
4. Parking- We have received permission from Adler Management Company for the use of their seven parking areas totaling 1,255 spaces. Parking addresses are as follows:

7875 has 142 spaces

7855 has 39 spaces

1200 has 203 spaces

7925 has 158 spaces

7955 has 285 spaces

8095 has 215 spaces

8175 has 213 spaces

Total 1,255 spaces

We had to provide insurance information liability and a deposit was given. We are responsible for the clean up of their parking lots after the party and provided them a \$1,000 deposit for guarantee. We also provided them with our insurance information listing them as secondary insurers.

5. All our flyers and ads in the news papers encourage responsible alcohol consumption.
6. Cleanup- We have contracted the services of a cleaning crew during the event to maintain a clean and safe environment they will also be back in the morning to complete a detail cleaning of all surrounding areas.
7. Responsible alcohol service, with the partnership of our vendors we are using two computerized ID machines, placing wrist bands on all guests over 21.
8. Lighting- we have six double lighting poles, each with 1,000 watts. In addition we will have two light towers each with a capacity of 4,000 watts.

Once again, we are committed and determined to organize a great fun event and safe for everyone.

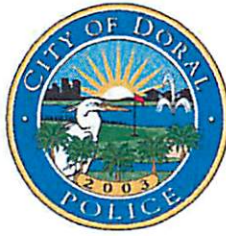

BACKGROUND:

The City of Doral has received an application to hold an outdoor event at the Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant located 8191 NW 12th Street. The event will be for the "Cinco de Mayo" Mexican cultural holiday on Thursday, May 5, 2016. This event will host two (2) live DJs, a live music band, serving of alcoholic beverages and selling of food. This event will partially be held outdoors within the restaurant's parking lot. The event will begin at 4:00 p.m. and end at 2:00 a.m. The promoter estimates that this year's event will host approximately one thousand two hundred (1200) patrons. In addition to hiring extra duty police officers from the Doral Police Department the promoter, Chevy's Fresh Mex, will be hiring a minimum of six (6) private unarmed security guards who will be stationed both inside and outside the venue. They will be wearing black shirts labeled "Security" on their backs; and will be present during the entire event. In addition, the restaurant has rented parking spaces from the adjoining Commerce Center. The police department will provide security and assist with traffic control.

The following are suggested alcohol requirements for this event:

- Event's license to sell/distribute alcoholic beverages must be provided prior to obtaining final permit from the city;
- License to sell/distribute alcoholic beverages must be posted at each point of sale;
- All alcohol beverage sales must end an hour prior to event end time;
- Alcoholic beverage sold to patrons "over 21 I.D." presented;
- No glass containers permitted; and,
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages will be restricted to the main event area only – no one will be allowed to drink alcoholic beverages in the parking areas.

Patrons who bring their own alcoholic beverages to the event will not be allowed to remain and consume these beverages. Anyone found to be bringing alcoholic beverages into the event will be asked to leave the event. It is recommended that the promoter erect signage throughout the event in which it specifically states that alcohol consumption will only be allowed in the main event area.

PREVIOUS INCIDENTS AND ARRESTS:

During last year's Chevy's Cinco de Mayo event there were no incident(s) reported.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that extra-duty police officers be hired on Thursday, May 5, 2016, for the Chevy's Fresh Mex Restaurant "Cinco de Mayo" Mexican cultural event. The event will begin at 4:00 p.m. and conclude at 2:00 a.m. The staffing for this event will be one (1) Sergeant and four (4) Officers beginning at 4pm and one (1) Sergeant and four (4) Officers arriving at 8:00 p.m. All Sergeants and Officers will remain until the conclusion of the event at 2:00 a.m.
