

RESOLUTION No. 15-81

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC., A PRE-QUALIFIED CITY VENDOR, FOR DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE EXTENSION OF NW 92 AVENUE FROM NW 27TH STREET TO NW 33RD STREET IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEED \$80,812.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral's (the "City") Public Works Department wishes to secure a firm to proceed with design services for the extension of NW 92nd Avenue from NW 27th Street to NW 33rd Street; and

WHEREAS, Marlin Engineering, Inc. ("Marlin") is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act requirements and approved by the City Council in December 2014; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council approve the Work Order with Marlin Engineering, Inc. to proceed with the design services for the extension of NW 92nd Avenue from NW 27th Street to NW 33 Street; in an amount not to exceed \$80,812.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval & Authorization. The Work Order between the City of Doral and Marlin Engineering Inc. for design services on NW 92nd Avenue from NW 27th Street to NW 33rd Street; in an amount not to exceed \$80,812.00, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference, is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Work Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of Marlin Engineering, Inc. to provide professional design engineering services for the extension of NW 92 Avenue from NW 27 Street to NW 33 Street. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Final Agreement between Marlin Engineering, Inc. and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2015, and the attached Proposal submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from Marlin Engineering, Inc. The schedule requires the work to be performed within 180 calendar days. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a Time and Materials basis with a not to exceed amount of \$80,812.00.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 2, 2015 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.
