

RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 96

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SANCHEZ ZEINALI & ASSOCIATES (SZA) FOR THE PROVISION OF CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE MISSING SECTION OF N.W. 112TH AVENUE FROM 79TH LANE TO 82ND STREET IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$64,651.00; RECOGNIZING THAT SZA IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department seeks to move forward with the construction of the missing section of N.W. 112 Avenue from N.W. 79th Lane to N.W. 82 Street; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Sanchez Zeinali & Associates (SZA), a City of Doral pre-qualified vendor, for the provision of construction engineering inspection services for the missing section of N.W. 112th Avenue as stated above in an amount not to exceed \$64,651.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with SZA, a City of Doral pre-qualified vendor, for the provision of construction engineering inspection services for the missing section of N.W. 112th Avenue as stated in the above "whereas" clause in an amount not to exceed \$64,651.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
