A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND INCORPORATE ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT WITH **EVERGREEN** THE PROVISION SOLUTIONS, INC. **FOR** CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and incorporate an addendum to the Evergreen Solutions, Inc. agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$11,900.00, for the provision of a Classification and Compensation Plan for the City of Doral Police Department.
