

RESOLUTION No. 15-208

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SECOND FARMERS' MARKET PERMIT FOR ECOTEM INC. TO BE HELD AT DORAL CENTRAL PARK, LOCATED AT 3000 NW 87TH AVENUE, DORAL, FLORIDA 33172, ON SATURDAYS FROM OCTOBER 31, 2015 TO FEBRUARY 13, 2016 BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 A.M. TO 4:00 P.M. SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS; On June 15, 2015, the City Council discussed the possibility of a second Doral Farmer's Market; and

WHEREAS; the City's Farmer's Market contribute to the health of the residents by improving the availability of fresh, nutritious and affordable food within the Community; and

WHEREAS; pursuant to Section 74-862 of the City Code private farmer's market permit may be issued for a maximum length of four (4) consecutive months per year. Additional time may be considered by the City Council through a full submittal of the private farmers' market application; and

WHEREAS; Ecotem, Inc, ("Applicant") seeks approval of a second "Doral Farmer's Market" to be held at Doral Central Park, located at 3000 NW 87th Avenue, Doral, Florida 33172 on Saturday's from October 31, 2015 to February 13, 2016 between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm ; and

WHEREAS; after careful review of the application, staff has determined that this application has complied with the Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated

herein.

Section 2. Approval. Staff respectfully recommends that Council approve the proposed second “Doral Farmer’s Market” to be held at Doral Central Park, located at 3000 NW 87th Avenue, Doral, Florida 33172 on Saturday’s from October 31, 2015 to February 13, 2016 between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm, subject to the following conditions:


1. Construction plans for tents (larger than 10 X 10) and any structural facility must be submitted to the Building Department for approval.
2. Each vendor providing food shall acquire a valid food establishment permit issued by the state department of agriculture and consumer services.
3. All trash and refuse must be removed from the site at the end of each day.
4. Lighting must be provided during morning set up prior to sunrise, if applicable.
5. Applicant shall furnish liability insurance of \$1,000,000 with the City as the certificate holder.
6. Farmer’s Market operator shall have all required permits, including City Council approval prior to the opening of the Farmer’s Market.
7. Applicant shall comply with comments made by the Parks and Recreation Department.
8. Applicant shall comply with the conditions proposed or adopted by the Mayor and City Council.
9. Applicant shall comply with Chapter 74, Article XII, Farmer’s Market, Sec. 74-861 through 74-864, as amend from time to time.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
