

RESOLUTION No. 07 – 25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH CHAMELEON DESIGNS, LLC FOR THE PROVISION OF SOUND LIGHTING, AND VIDEO SERVICES FOR THE INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION AT J.C. BERMUDEZ PARK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral City Council takes pride in the observance of our nation's Independence Day and seeks to provide a high-quality celebration for the enjoyment of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the Request for Proposals (RFP) process and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Chameleon Designs, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00, for the provision of sound lighting and video services for the Independence Day celebration at J.C. Bermudez Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby waives the RFP process and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Chameleon Designs, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00, for the provision of sound lighting and video services for the Independence Day celebration at J.C. Bermudez Park.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council.


