

RESOLUTION NO. 03-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CITY MANAGER, AND CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE TERMS AND FINALIZE THE INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT; REQUESTING THE RELEASE OF MUNICIPAL FUNDS FOR INTERIM ORGANIZATIONAL EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY FROM EXISTING REVENUES ACCRUED BY THE COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County (the "County") has offered the City of Doral (the "City") an advance of funds to be utilized by the City for the initiation and start-up of municipal government and the performance of initial municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the County on August 28, 2003 delivered to the City the amount of \$300,000 for organization expenditures; and

WHEREAS, this initial amount is not sufficient to cover the City's organizational and start up costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. **Approval of Form.** The City Council hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County (the "County") and the City to receive municipal funds necessary for interim organizational expenditures of the City from existing revenues accrued by the County on behalf of the City, largely in the form prescribed in the attached Exhibit "A".

Section 3. Authorization to Negotiate. The Mayor, City Manager, and City Attorney are authorized to negotiate future releases of municipal funds from Miami-Dade County.

Section 4. Execution of Agreement. The Mayor is authorized to execute this Interlocal Agreement.

Section 5. Release of Funds. The City Council hereby requests the immediate release of funds from the County for interim organizational expenditures of the City from existing revenues accrued by the County on behalf of the City.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Cabrera, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Ruiz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

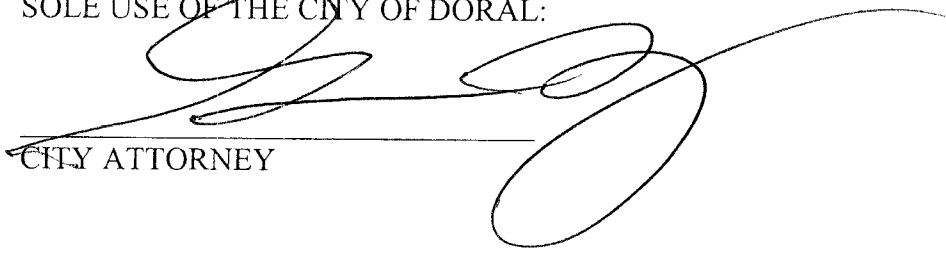
