

RESOLUTION NO. 03-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE HOLIDAY RELATED SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR A DETERMINATION OF IMPRACTICABILITY AS TO COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that holiday signs will contribute to the City of Doral (the “City”) sense of community; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in ordering the holiday signs in order for the signs to be delivered this holiday season; and

WHEREAS, a competitive process is not practical and may result in the City not timely receiving the holiday signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Holiday Signs. The City Manager is hereby authorized in conjunction with the City Community Identity Advisory Committee to purchased holiday signs for the City, in the amount not to exceed \$25,000.

Section 3. Competitive Process . Even though the competitive process is waived, the City Manager is instructed to use its best efforts to select a company which is a competitively selected vendor in another jurisdiction.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Sandra Ruiz,
who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Michael DiPietro and upon


